Your scouts could earn up to four merit badges. Most classes will include 2 hour periods on both days.

There will be no prerequisites, but scouts will have tasks assigned during the first class, to be completed before the second class. This is why there is a weekend between classes.

Note that most of the merit badges include those from the occupational and hobby areas. They will be taught by adults in the trades or knowledgeable hobbyists. All scouts will be required to obtain and read the BSA Merit Badge Booklet for each badge they plan to work on. BSA Merit Badge Booklets will be available at ScoutStuff.org, the Council Service Center, Florence, and at the door in limited quantities.

The cost of the Merit Badge College is \$15 per scout, plus a can of food for each merit badge class the scout is registered for. The food goes to a local food bank. There will be an additional cost for Electronics Merit Badge to cover supplies. The councilor will contact those scouts before class. Scouts will register on line and pay the fee on the first class day. Registration is on a first come first served basis. We would like to keep the classes to 15 or less students. Registration will open on the 1st of December and close on the 15th of January. An email registration form is available on the January calendar page of the district web site <[chcorad.com](http://chcorad.com)>. You will not be able to register at the door. Registration will be by troop or individuals with the approval of the Scoutmaster.

There is a lunch break from 11 to 12. Scouts should bring their own lunch. Lunch will not be provided.
